The Colors of the Seasons



CHERRY BISCUITS

2 C flour
4 tsp. baking powder
1/4 tsp. baking soda
3/4 tsp. salt
2 Tbsp. butter
2 Tbsp. shortening
1 C buttermilk (very cold)
1/2 C dried sweet cherries

Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt in a large mixing bowl. Using your hands, combine butter and shortening with dry ingredients until mixture looks like crumbs. Make a well in the center and pour in the chilled buttermilk. Stir just until the dough comes together. Add cherries. Turn dough onto floured surface, dust top with flour and gently fold dough over on itself 5 or 6 times. Press into a 1-inch thick round. Cut out biscuits with a biscuit cutter. Place biscuits on baking sheet so that they just touch. Bake at 450 degrees until biscuits are tall and light gold on top, 15 to 20 minutes.

CHOCOLATE BUTTER

2 C butter
2 Tbsp. sugar
2 Tbsp. Coco powder

Beat ingredients in a small bowl until mixed and smooth. Mixture will keep for two weeks in the refrigerator.



The Finger Lakes region has long been a favorite place for bird watching. A variety of water fowl and backyard varieties combined with great natural settings make for a day of great fun. Upstate New York is filled with beautiful lakes, parks and many natural wonders. Most everyone has heard of one of its most popular, Niagara Falls. Did you



know that the region boasts hundreds of other waterfalls. Many located here in the Finger Lakes region. Among the most scenic are Taughannock Falls. It is located eight miles north of Ithaca on NY Route 89 on the Westside of Cayuga Lake. Spend the day climbing the stairs of Watkins Glenn State Park located at the southern tip of Seneca Lake off NY Route 14. Often called the "Grand Canyon of the East" Letchworth State Park is 35 miles southwest of Rochester is known for its expansive 14,000 acres of natural beauty as the Genesee river winds through the parks and features three of the most spectacular waterfalls in the region. Spend the day attending one of these exciting events. The George Eastman Museum's Dutch Connection flowering bulb exhibit February 2019. In the spring Rochester Lilac Festival in May at Highlands Park, It's 10 days of free activities and great smelling flowers! Stroll down the Eire Canal Path or through some of the area parks to see some of the hundreds of wildflower varieties that bloom in the Finger Lakes. You might even spy a babe in the woods.



Sonnenberg Gardens and Mansion State Park is also a great outing. Plan early to attend Rochester's International Jazz Festival in June, if you haven't been to this event, it is a must not miss and it lasts 10 days. Apple Picking and Harvest Festivals are among our guests fall favorites.
